APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Compulsory:

- 1. CV (updated and including picture)
- 2. Master degree certificate or similar
- Short outline of the PhD research proposal (1 page excluding references) according to the provided template (see addendum)

All submitted documents should be in English

Highly recommended:

- English language skills IELTS 6.5 (applicants who hold an IELTS 6.5 or equivalent certificate will be given priority)
- Acceptance letter from a Dutch university (PhD students who hold an admission letter from a Dutch University will be given priority)

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ASSESSMENT PROCEDURE

The selection committee of the PhD-Consortium Indonesia will first assess the quality of the preliminary PhD research proposal. The submitted outline should:

- a) Be clear and address a relevant topic (scientific and societal relevance)
- b) Provide a sound and concise introduction to the PhD research topic
- c) Explain the problem to be studied (problem statement) and why it is important to address this problem (research justification)

- d) Include a well formulated research question
- e) Provide an overview of the proposed methodological approach
- f) Include the list of references used

- The selection committee will then review the CVs and check the applicants' merit during the undergraduate and postgraduate years as well as the other application requirements.
- As part of the assessment procedure, the committee might contact the PhD students for further information and inquiries.
- Applicants will be informed about the outcome of the selection process by 25 May.

- Applicants are sent a formal email informing them of the committee's decision and the reasons underlying this.
- At this point they are also sent an invoice or options for payment for the participation in the programme.

All direct communication regarding the application/assessment procedure will be through Erasmus Training Centre, Jakarta.
