

<u>I will make all appointments for you and for other professors.</u> The appointments will be scheduled per table. This year we have three tables, therefore three agendas: Table 1 (XX and YY)-all faculties, VUmc and ACTA, Table 2 (AA en BB), special focus on FSciences, FSW, FHumanities, SBE, Table 3 (MM and NN)-all faculties.

In attachment I am sending some short TIPS for interviewing and selecting candidates + list of top 30 universities and relevant fields for CSC.

Follow up procedure:

If you are still interested in the candidates please contact them directly and schedule a skype call for further evaluation. If after this evaluation you are positive we can move forward with conditional registration of candidates that will apply for a CSC scholarship. I can then help with the preparation of two letters as well as with making sure they are able to get accommodation and visa in time. Please contact me for further assistance via this email.

I am also sending some winning proposals from last year so that you know how the research proposal should be structured.
